

Reminder to Mintabie residents:

Mintabie residents are reminded that Fees for 2018/2019 township licences are payable by 30 September 2018

To reside in Mintabie, residents are required to hold a current 2018-19 Residential Licence or Commercial Licence, issued in accordance with the Mintabie Township Lease Agreement and the A<u>n</u>angu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara Land Rights Act 1981.

As previously notified on 29 June 2018, the South Australian Government has written to the Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara (APY) Executive Board to give notice of the termination of the Mintabie Township Lease, effective 30 June 2019. Control over the township area will transfer on that date from the Government to the APY. After 30 June 2019, the government will no longer have an ability to issue any licences at Mintabie.

Fees for 2018-19 township licences fell due on 1 July 2018. Residents are reminded they required to fulfil all requirements for lease application, including full payment of licence fees, by no later than 30 September 2018.

Government officers are planning a follow-up visit to Mintabie in the near future, to update residents regarding the transition of the township area and support that may be available to help residents deal with the transition.
