About Neoen

Founded in 2008, Neoen is one of the world's leading independent producers of exclusively renewable energy, with expertise in power generation – solar and onshore wind power – and storage. Neoen plays an active role in accelerating the energy transition of the countries where it operates by delivering clean, competitively-priced local energy. Neoen is a high-growth company: its capacity in operation or under construction has quadrupled over the last six years, and now stands at 8.9 GW, with the ambition to reach 10 GW in 2025.

Neoen operates near close to 200 assets across three continents. Its flagships include Western Downs Green Power Hub in Australia, comprised of the largest solar farm in the country (460 MWp) and Western Downs Battery (212 MW / 424 MWh); Collie Battery (219 MW / 877 MWh) one of the world's most powerful large-scale storage systems; France's most powerful solar farm (300 MWp) in Cestas; and Finland's largest wind farm (404 MW) in Mutkalampi.

Neoen is listed in Compartment A of Euronext's market in Paris (ISIN code: FR0011675362, Ticker: NEOEN). Since December 27, 2024, Neoen is majority-owned by Brookfield Renewable Holdings SAS, which filed in January 2025 a simplified cash tender offer for the remaining Neoen shares and OCEANES.

Role purpose

Our **Procurement Department** is looking for a **Procurement Analyst** for our headquarter in Paris, France. The Procurement Analyst will be managed by a Procurement Manager, will focus on the American Area and will have the following missions:

- Upstream – Support to the Development Department team members:
 - Gather information with regards to the technologies/equipments to be implemented on our next projects;
 - Assist on the crafting of forecast pricing based on our various platforms, and forecast the deliveries in line with project(s) expected time-schedule;
 - Prepare and present market soundings on the different key players from an industrial point of view (who are the main EPCs, WTG suppliers, BESS suppliers and PV Modules suppliers that have been involved in the past projects for such geography and fit with our requirements in terms of ESG, HSE policy, financial strength, carbon footprint policy etc.).
- Downstream – Assist the Procurement Manager in the preparation of the negotiations with EPCs and strategic suppliers once a project has been granted to the Development Department:
 - Assist in the preparation of the documents for the release of the RFP;
 - Analyze and synthesize offers received from the EPCs and strategic suppliers;
 - Prepare, negotiate and recommend to the Procurement Manager the most suited EPC and strategic suppliers;
 - Assist the Procurement Manager on the negotiation phases and contractual closing.
- Other matter of importance:
 - Do the regular market intelligence to have precise knowledge of the market trends on all renewable technologies;
 - Prepare and perform audits of the strategic suppliers (360°, financial audits, ESG, quality, E&HS).

Candidate profile

The candidate will need the following skills and experience to succeed in this role:

- Last year of a Bachelor or Master's Degree student or undertaking a PhD in Science, Engineering, Applied Mathematics, Business, Finance or Data Science (essential);
- Experience in the renewable industry or construction (desirable);
- Solid analytical skills, strong adaptability, efficiency (essential)
- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail (essential)
- Ability to work independently and on several projects in parallel (essential)
- Strong interpersonal skills, excellent oral and written expression and ability to effectively interact with a wide range of internal and external stakeholders (essential)

- Intellectual curiosity, passion and self-motivation (essential)
- Proactive and curious, with strong appetite for international collaboration (essential)
