The Department of Energy and Mining (**DEM**) refers to the Program that was approved on 30 July 2025. The associated approval letter listed two conditions to which the Program was subject that related to the Tailings Storage Facility (**TSF**), being:

- The Tenement Holder must submit the final TSF Raise 9 design to the Director Minerals Regulation for approval prior to construction of TSF Raise 9.*
- The Tenement Holder must submit evidence to the Director Minerals Regulation that the final TSF Raise 9 design has been reviewed and endorsed by a suitably qualified, third-party expert.*

On 29 August 2025 you submitted to DEM "Response to Notice of Program Approval Conditions for MPEPR2024/031" (the **Submission**).

On 9 September 2025 you submitted to DEM an email with additional information including a letter from you dated 9 September 2025 supporting the Submission after meeting with DEM staff on 8 September 2025.

DEM has reviewed the Submission and the additional information provided and is satisfied the conditions specified in the Program have been met.

DEM notes the commitments you have made in your Submission including, but not limited to, those set out in the letter dated 9 September 2025, which outlined quarterly construction updates of the TSF Raise 9 to DEM, inclinometer and Vibrating Wire Piezometer (**VWP**) installations, VWP monitoring and redundancy and validation of critical VWP's.

You are reminded that you must always implement and comply with the approved Program.
