Pursuant to Regulation 77 (3b) of the Mining Regulations, the reporting period ending on the anniversary of the day on which the oldest mineral tenement comprising this operation was granted (17 October).</p> <p>For the purposes of regulation 77(4)(a) of the Mining Regulations, it is determined that a mining compliance report must be submitted annually within 60 days after the end of each reporting period (due by 16 December in any year). Please refer to the DEM website for more information on the reporting requirements.</p>
3	<p>Work, Health and Safety Compliance</p> <p>In accordance with Chapter 10 of the <i>Work Health and Safety Regulations 2012 (SA)</i>, you must meet the requirements for mine operators in South Australia, which include a notification for mining operations, the establishment of a Safety Management System, the identification of Principal Mining Hazards and development of a Principal Mining Hazard Management Plan.
