***Mining Act 1971 – NOTIFICATION OF APPROVED MINE OPERATIONS PLAN (MOP) AND PROGRAM FOR ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION AND REHABILITATION (PROGRAM) FOR PRIVATE MINES 3, 4 and 22; and MINERAL LEASES (MLs) 5730, 5731, 5732 and 6525 – LINWOOD QUARRY***

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The Program for the Linwood Quarry (Version 2), as submitted on 2 December 2022, has been approved by the Department for Energy and Mining (the Department) as Program Number MPEPR2022/154 in accordance with Sections 70B(5), 70C(5) and 73G(11)(a) of the *Mining Act 1971* (the Mining Act).

Boral Resources (SA) Limited (Boral) is reminded that it must implement and always comply with this approved Program.

This approval does not constitute endorsement of the systems that Boral has in place to manage the mining operations in compliance with the Mining Act. Whilst Boral's capability to undertake this activity has been considered in this approval, the responsibility for compliance with the Mining Act always remains with the Tenement Holder.

**Program Conditions**

In accordance with section 70B(7a) and 70C(7a) of the Mining Act, the approved Program is subject to the conditions listed in the attached notice (**see Attachment 1**).

**Native Vegetation**

The native vegetation clearance and payment into the Native Vegetation Fund as set out in the Program is approved in accordance with my delegated powers under the *Native Vegetation Regulations 2017*.

The Program includes a native vegetation management plan for the clearance of 0.5 ha and 0.31 ha of vegetation on ML 6525 and EML 5732, respectively. The Significant Environmental Benefit (SEB) for the removal of this vegetation has been calculated as **\$2,793.09** for ML 6525 and **\$1,146.83** for EML 5732 (a total of **\$3,939.92**). Please note that payment must be provided before any clearance is undertaken.

Please notify the Department if you would like an invoice for the SEB to be raised by the Native Vegetation Council and forwarded to you so that payment can be made.

### **Compliance Reporting**

You are required to submit an Annual Compliance Report. As with the existing arrangements for the Linwood Quarry, the reporting period will commence from 14 September and the compliance report must be submitted within 2 calendar months of the recurring anniversary of that date (on or before 14 November annually). Please refer to the [DEM website](#) for more information on the reporting requirements.

### **Work, Health and Safety Act 2012**

In accordance with Chapter 10 of the Work Health and Safety Regulations 2012 (SA), you must meet the requirements for mine operators in South Australia which include a notification for mining operations, the establishment of a Safety Management System, the identification of Principal Mining Hazards and development of a Principal Mining Hazard Management Plan. Further information on your responsibilities, including a guide to Chapter 10, and the Mine Operator Notification Form, is available on SafeWork SA [website](#).

### **Environment Protection Authority (EPA) Authorisation**

Under the requirements of the *Environment Protection Act 1993*, Boral is required to comply with the conditions of EPA licence number 1187 for this operation.

Please be advised that the licence may require amendments due to activities proposed in the Program. Boral is encouraged to contact the EPA as soon as possible to discuss licence requirements.

### **Landscape South Australia Act 2019**

Linwood quarry is located within the Central Adelaide Prescribed Wells Area. Under the requirements of the *Landscape South Australia Act 2019*, a **water licence** is required for groundwater extraction/use.

## **Attachment 1 – Notice of Program Approval Conditions for MPEPR2022/154**

In accordance with section 70B(7a) and 70C(7a) of the Mining Act, this notice is provided to the Tenement Holder, “Boral Resources (SA) Ltd”, to specify the following conditions to which the approved Program is subject to:

### **1. Overburden Management**

1.1. The Tenement Holder of ML 6525 must only place overburden into two areas:

- 1.1.1. The quarry pit within the “ramp” area as marked in the plan “Quarry Development Plan Stage 1 – Cross Section Plan (Drawing No. 1802.DRG.096)” and/or
- 1.1.2. Private Mine 4.

1.2. The Tenement Holder must ensure this condition is implemented for the duration of the Program.

*Explanatory Note: These conditions are necessary to ensure achievement of mine closure and completion outcomes.*

### **2. Program Review**

2.1. The Tenement Holder must revise and update the Program.

2.2. The revised Program must address the following:

- 2.2.1. Second Schedule Condition 3 of ML 6525 - Post Mining Land Use Plan, for the whole of the Linwood Quarry.
- 2.2.2. Provision of evidence that landowners have been engaged and consulted in development of the plans required by Clause 2.2.1.

2.3. The revised and updated Program must be submitted within 12 months of the date of this letter, or a longer period as approved by the Director Mining Regulation.
