RE: Comments on Mining Proposal MC 4541

As per the attached plan Erimar Quarries Pty Ltd (Erimar) are planning to access their operation over our extractive mineral lease (EML 6522).

To enable this access to occur Clay & Mineral Sales, Bromley Farms (the land owner where the access track is going) and Erimar will need to sign a legal agreement setting out obligations between the parties. The legal agreement will need to be signed by all parties and must be in place prior to any road works or access taking place.

An example as to why an agreement between the parties is required are as follows;

- (1) Hours of access.
- (2) Responsibility of the access point (maintenance) and safety at Chaunceys Line Road.
- (3) Responsibility on the construction of the gates, new road and fencing.
- (4) Safety whilst on EML 6522 and Bromley Farms land.
- (5) Control of rubbish from construction and demolition waste on EML 6522 and Bromley Farms land.
- (6) Public Liability and legal indemnity.
- (7) Tarping of trucks and maximum speed limits.
- (8) Who is responsible for the maintenance of the road and control of environmental issues including noise and dust.

In summary there are certain obligations in operating EML 6522. The extra activity from Erimar will increase the potential off site impacts from our site. These potential off impacts need to be addressed by an agreement between the parties.
