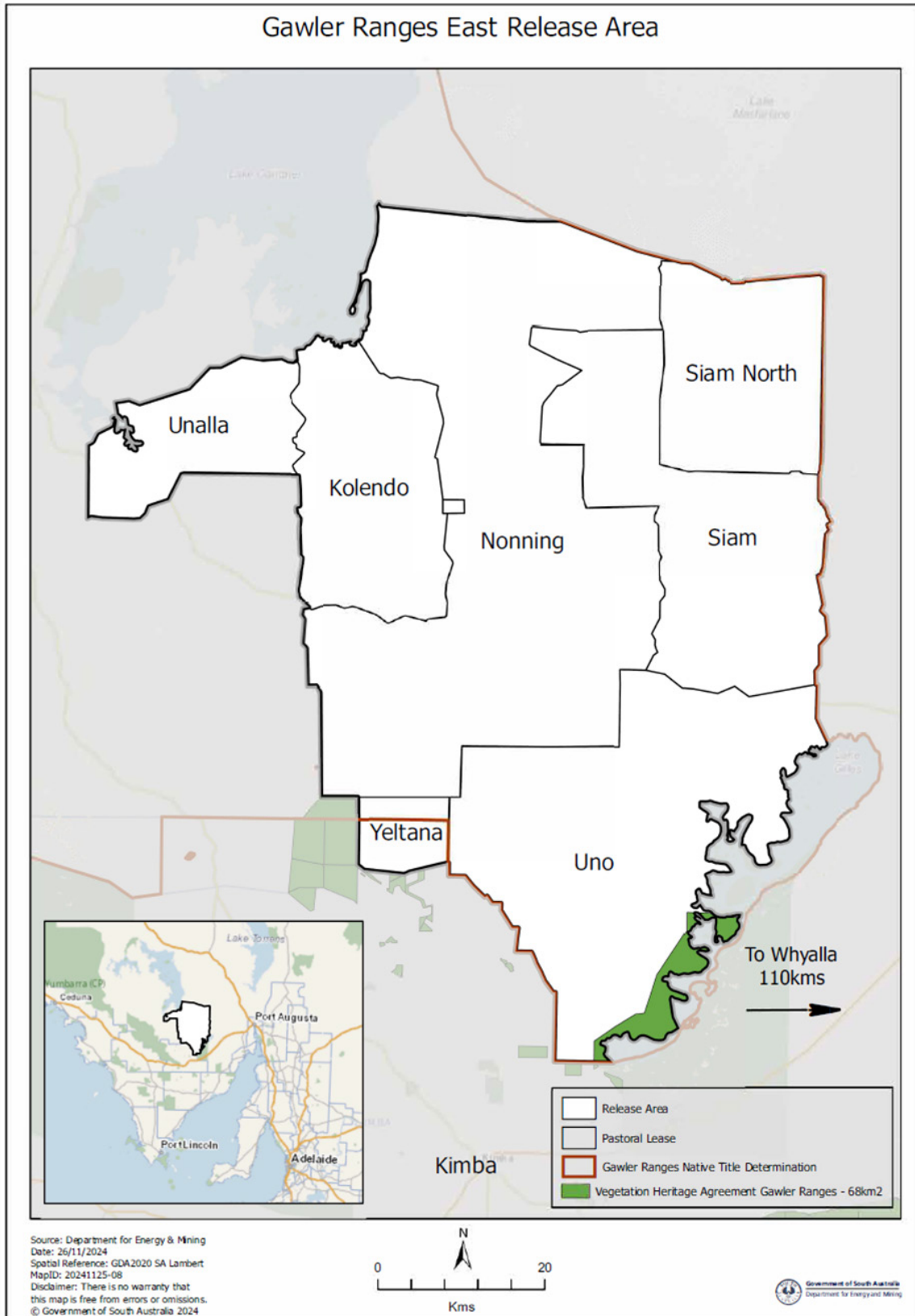
Gawler Ranges East – Native Vegetation Heritage Agreement HA1501

Gawler Ranges East release area includes Native Vegetation Heritage Agreement HA1501 which covers approximately 68km² and is located along the boundary of Uno pastoral lease and Lake Giles Conservation Park (see map below).

The *Native Vegetation Act 1991* (NV Act) provides protection for native vegetation in South Australia and sets out the process for applying to clear vegetation. The Native Vegetation Council is responsible for providing advice and making decisions about the clearance and re-establishment of native vegetation in line with the Act. A licence issued under the *Hydrogen and Renewable Energy Act 2023* does not provide approval to clear native vegetation.

Applicants are advised that access to a heritage agreement area is subject to the regulatory requirements and approvals under the NV Act. The clearance of native vegetation and the construction of buildings, other structures or roads on land under a heritage agreement is generally not supported. Access to this area is likely to necessitate a variation to, or removal of, the existing heritage agreement which requires the approval of the Minister for Climate, Environment and Water and the Native Vegetation Council.
