**Re: Request for Extension — Cooper Basin Logistics Support Hub (November 2020)
— Statement of Environmental Objectives (SEO) — 5 year review**

The Department for Energy and Mining (DEM) on 15 August 2025 received a request from Landtrak for an extension of time on the Cooper Basin Logistics Support Hub (November 2020) five-year SEO review.

DEM understands that the Cooper Basin Logistics Support Hub (Cooper Parks) is currently non-operational and remains in a mothballed state. Landtrak are assessing the commercial viability for Cooper Parks and seek an extension of time to complete that assessment which will then inform any review and subsequent revision of the SEO.

Therefore, Pursuant to Section 134 of the *Energy Resources Act 2000* (ER Act), DEM grant an extension of time for the review and submission of the revised SEO to 31 December 2026 or prior to any proposal for the recommissioning and operation of Cooper Parks, whichever comes first.

Noting the recent changes to the ER Act, it is expected that any revised documents will have been developed in accordance with the revised ER Act and associated regulations, prior to formal submission to DEM for consideration under the ER Act. Until such time, the ongoing management of Cooper Parks, and all associated activities within SFL 2, must comply with the requirements of the Cooper Basin Logistics Support Hub SEO, gazetted in November 2020.
