2	<b>Commencement of Operations</b> Notify DEM prior to commencement of mining operations on ML 6564.
3	<b>Compliance Reporting</b> You are required to submit an annual compliance report. The reporting period will commence from 5 August 2025 and the compliance report must be submitted within 2 calendar months of the recurring anniversary of the reporting period (before <b>5 October</b> annually). Please refer to the DEM <a href="#">website</a> for more information on the reporting requirements.
4	<b>Work, Health and Safety Compliance</b> In accordance with Chapter 10 of the <i>Work Health and Safety Regulations 2012 (SA)</i> , you must meet the requirements for mine operators in South Australia, which include a notification for mining operations, the establishment of a Safety Management System, the identification of Principal Mining Hazards and development of a Principal Mining Hazard Management Plan. Further information on your responsibilities, including a guide to Chapter 10, and the Mine Operator Notification Form, is available on the <a href="#">SafeWork SA website</a> .
5	<b>Environment Protection Authority (EPA) Authorisation</b> Under the requirements of the <i>Environment Protection Act 1993 (SA)</i> , you are required to engage with the EPA to discuss the requirement for a variation to the existing EPA licence number <b>50331</b> (which covers operations on CT 5896/646 and CT 5896/647). You are required to comply with the conditions of EPA licence number <b>50331</b> for this operation.

In addition to the requirements under the Mining Act, you are reminded that your operation will have other legislative requirements that you will need to comply with.
