Bioenergy Connect (Department for Energy and Mining DEM & RDA)

- The Government of South Australia funds the Bioenergy Roadmap Program.
- Bioenergy Connect, is a \$22,500 program. Successful applicants are allocated a bioenergy mentor to guide them through the conceptual stage of developing a project and help estimate the benefits of the bioenergy technology to the business.
